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SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Up to three \$500 awards will be made each term to students who have worked for social change and whose future goals will be strengthened by a HECUA semester program. Some additional scholarship money is available for January Interim programs. Students must have applied to a HECUA program in order to be eligible. HECUA offers academic programs which emphasize a high level of student involvement in learning with a focus on inequality and ways to bring about change in society. Programs are interdisciplinary, experiential, integrated and include internships, independent study projects and/or small group projects.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 1) Your scholarship essay showing the match between your goals and the HECUA program.
- A strong letter of recommendation.
- 3) Financial need (students who do not qualify for aid may apply). This is a merit-based scholarship; however, among equally deserving candidates financial need may be considered. Please note in your essay if there are financial considerations. No outside materials (FAFSA forms) are required.
